Central States Pension Fund (CSPF) cuts will wreck families and communities in this area if retirees suffer the loss of their hard earned pensions. The DOL's Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA) is supposed to be the watchdog and protector of benefits security, which includes pensions. Why is the EBSA not investigating the loss of the \$10 billion dollars that went missing or got stolen from the CSPF in 2008-2009 by Goldman Sachs? The Missouri-Kansas City Committee to Protect Pensions (MKCCPP) would like to know why the EBSA is doing nothing to recover our retirement funds.

Meanwhile in Washington, D.C., Senator Bernie Sanders and Rep. Marcy Kaptur are reintroducing the Keep Our Pension Promises Act (KOPPA) today, May 9<sup>th</sup>. If enacted, KOPPA will provide a funding solution for the many endangered multiemployer pension funds that currently cover 10 million workers in this country. It will create a legacy fund by closing a couple of tax loopholes used by billionaires for tax shelters. This legislation is supported by the National United Committee to Protect Pensions (NUCPP) and the MKCCPP.
